Our eco-responsible approach

Aware of the fragile balance of our planet and our responsibilities, the Hotel Villa d'Elsa is committed to carrying out a number of eco-responsible actions.

We try to be as active and preventive as possible through common sense actions and eco-citizen gestures.

Our Eco-responsible approach

Energy Management

We encouraged the installation of motion detectors in order to reduce the energy use of lighting in common areas (corridors and airlocks). Each room is equipped with a contactor which allows power to be supplied to the room only when people are present. We are gradually replacing our lights by opting for low-consumption bulbs and LEDs.

The air conditioning in our establishment is reversible and has individual thermostats.

We ensure **that our electrical installation is regularly maintained** to ensure good general operation.

Our Eco-responsible approach Water wavings

- All our showers, faucets and toilets are equipped with **water-saving systems**. We have also limited the number of washing machines and dishwashers to only 3 rooms.
 - It is as natural as **it is essential to raise awareness within our hotel staff** to potential leaks that can lead to significant water losses.

Waste management کړک

- We have limited our individual packaging by using Eco pump 2 in 1 product rechargeable.
- We also participate in **selective sorting** in the city of Antibes Juan-les-Pins.
- With your help, the use of the sorting bin and the several sorting areas around the hotel, we contribute to recycling and to respect the environment (bulbs, batteries, cardboard, glasses, etc.).

We want to be part of a long-term eco responsible approach.

We therefore make all our staff aware of these actions and we regularly evaluate the means implemented.

During your stay at the Hotel Villa d'Elsa, you too can support our action with simple gestures and we will follow your instructions for changing towels.

On foot – zero impact and enjoy the surroundings

Good for the environment, but also for your health!

The Villa d'Elsa hotel is ideally located on the pedestrian street in the heart of Juan-les-Pins, close to the Pinède, just a few minutes from the beaches, restaurants and shops. Cap d'Antibes is also a favorite route for joggers and the Tire-Poil trail attracts more and more visitors.

So, don't hesitate to go on a walk around the area and take a breath of fresh air.



By bike – zero impact, sporty and family

Faster and very ecological, cycling is a great option for **getting around the coast**, while exercising and enjoying the **Mediterranean landscape**.

The seaside cycle paths have been redeveloped and allow you to easily bike:

- from Antibes to Villeneuve-Loubet
- from Antibes to Cannes
- in the meanders of the Cap d'Antibes

You will find the perfect bike for your ride at the Pop Bike rent store located a little further up on Boulevard Wilson.

By bus – reduced impact by the collective effect and the use of electric vehicles

The Antibes area and its surroundings are very well served. **Why not travel like a local?** Sophia Antipolis, Cannes or Nice are just a bus ticket away! ***

- Line 6 takes you to the city center of Antibes and its old town.

By train – reduced impact by the collective effect



Juan-les-Pins train station is just 5 minutes from the hotel.

With a TER running every 30 minutes, **it is ideal for discovering the French Riviera** and getting to the city more easily.

The termini are on one side Ventimiglia (Italian border town known for its Friday market) passing through *Eze*, *Monaco*, *Nice* and **on the other Les Arcs Draguignan** (with the famous red rocks) serving *Cannes*, *Théoule-sur-Mer*, *Fréjus* on its route.
